Yves is currently the Writers' Assistant on *The Equalizer*. He previously worked on *Blackish, Grownish,* and *Queen Sugar,* where he received his first TV writing credit. Yves earned his MFA in Film and TV Production from the University of Southern California, where he wrote and directed award winning short films that have screened at various film festivals. Yves is dedicated to writing stories with honest portrayals of the Black experience. Most of his writing focuses on family dysfunction, coming of age stories, and stories with social and historical significance.
